- It is important for students to have a solid understanding of how math works. I fully support that. However, it feels like simply knowing basic math is missing from this. It's all very nice for students to have multiple ways to figure out multi-digit multiplication (327×149), for example, but if they have to mentally skip count or count on their fingers to figure out all of the simple multiplication (4×7) within in, they will get lost and frustrated.
- More emphasis needs to be put on all children receiving the learning material from the grade they are in or above, unfortunately with split classes it seems as though many of the lessons are at a lower level in order to meet the needs of the lower levelled grade. ie: many of the grade 2 work seems to be a repeat of last year-it so far is light years away from the "Canadian Curriculum Grade 2 Workbook"
